A species' response to fragmentation (effect size) was calculated as the mean difference in In(abundance) between fragments and controls. Points are means across species. Bars are 95 % confidence intervals. **A** and **B**, isolation on fragments or not in 1st and 3rd decades; **C** and **D**, trophic levels for all species in 1st and 3rd decades; **E** and **F**, trophic levels for isolated species only in 1st and 3rd decades.
